2009 Summer Program

TO:

This exciting summer program is carefully designed with promising young artists in mind. Along with 2 weeks of pre-school instruction, there are two age groups being offered each week; 6-8 and 9-12.

Students may arrive as early as 12:30 p.m. and pick-up will be through 5:30 p.m. Instruction is 1-4:30pm.
 Students will become well acquainted with basic art techniques using a variety of unique materials.

Instructors are chosen based on their history of successful projects and programs working with children at Spiva.

Preschool: Discover Art! Ages: 3, 4, 5 | June 16, 17, 18, 19 | 10-11:30am

Young artists will be introduced to color and shape, as well as a wide variety of artistic media, such as drawing, painting, clay, papier maché, and collage. Motor skills will be enhanced with a variety of kid-friendly themed projects, like dinosaurs, under the sea, wild things, and superheros. Vivid imaginations and parents are welcome!

Drawing First: June 23, 24, 25 | Ages 6-8 | Ages 9-12 | 1:00-4:30pm

Students will explore basic drawing techniques such as contour, blind contour, and sketching based on both observation and imagination. A variety of mark-making tools and surfaces are introduced. There will be a field trip to the Post Art Memorial Library to look at some great art books.

Painting is Primary: June 30, July 1, 2 | Ages 6-8 | Ages 9-12 | 1:00-4:30pm

Students will experiment with tempera and watercolor to create small paintings on a variety of subjects such as landscapes, portraits, and pattern-making.

3D for Me Part I: July 7, 8, 9 | Ages 6-8 | Ages 9-12 | 1:00-4:30pm

Paper-tube sculpture, mask-making, coil pots, assemblage...the possibilities are endless! Come construct and build with us. There will be a walking field trip to see various public sculpture installed in the downtown area.

Print This! July 14, 15, 16 | Ages 6-8 | Ages 9-12 | 1:00-4:30pm

Students make a multitude of monoprints, relief prints, rubbings, stencils, and stampings investigating subjects children love, such as animals, family, and community. They will explore prints in Spiva's permanent collection as sources of inspiration.

Fun with Fibers: July 21, 22, 23 | Ages 6-8 | Ages 9-12 | 1:00-4:30pm

All about PAPER: paper-making, paper manipulation, weaving, book-making. Students will explore Joplin's rich cultural history in textiles and craft as sources of inspiration.

Preschool: Discover Art! Ages: 3, 4, 5 | July 28, 29, 30, 31 | 10-11:30am

In this course, young artists will be introduced to color and shape, as well as a wide variety of artistic medias, such as drawing, painting, clay, papier maché, and collage. Glue It, Mix It! July 28, 29, 30 | Ages 6-8 | Ages 9-12 | 1:00-4:30pm

Projects will focus on collage elements and combining several techniques and mediums. Group projects, collaboration, and installation may be explored. Any material is fair game!

3D for Me Part II: August 4, 5, 6 | Ages 6-8 | Ages 9-12 | 1:00-4:30pm

Paper-tube sculpture, mask-making, coil pots, assemblage...the possibilities are endless! Come construct and build with us. There will be a walking field trip to view various public sculpture installed in the downtown area. This week will be a continuation of Part I. You don't have to be at Part I to be in Part II.

Picture Stories: August 11, 12, 13 | Ages 6-8 | Ages 9-12 | 1:00-4:30pm

Students will play with narrative, the idea that art can tell a story. Several mediums will be considered such as cartooning, photography, collage, drawing, and painting. Other artistic mediums may be introduced, such as movement and music.

****Sessions must have a minimum of 6 students enrolled for the class to be held.**

Maximum number of students per session: 12.

Digital Photography with Randy French

Learn the ins and outs of your digital camera, from point-and-shoots to digital SLRs. This class will explain camera controls (from f-stops to white balance) and how to use the tools of digital photography to make better pictures. Through hands-on experience, shooting, and editing, students will learn basic image adjustments in Photoshop, and produce digital prints in both black & white and color. Composition, shooting strategies, and artistic issues surrounding digital imagery will be discussed. Students should have a basic knowledge of computers and bring their camera, and manual to the first class.
